Reneéleona Dozier is currently serving as a business agent with IBEW Local 103 under leadership and mentorship of business manager Lou Antonellis. Her journey began as an apprentice with the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers (IBEW) Local 103, where she studied at the Joint Apprenticeship Training Center (JATC) and earned her Journeyman and Master's Electrical License. She is also the first black woman to serve as the wiring inspector for the City of Brockton, ensuring compliance with electrical codes and regulations. As the District 2 representative for the IBEW International Women's Committee, the Co-Chair of IBEW 103 Women's Committee, a member of IBEW 103's Electrical Minority Caucus, and a Trust Funds and JATC trustee, Reneéleona focuses on creating a level playing field for female, black, and brown members. She champions diversity, mentors aspiring electricians, and advocates for equal opportunities. She currently sits on the Board of State Examiners of Electricians, where she helps shape industry standards and ensures the competence of electrical professionals. Beyond her professional roles, Reneéleona actively engages with the community. Whether volunteering at local schools, shelters, food pantries, or participating in industry conferences, she and her union believe in giving back and inspiring the next generation.
