Mr. Goldwein is the senior vice president and senior policy director of the Committee for a Responsible Federal Budget (CRFB), where he guides and conducts research on a wide array of topics related to fiscal policy and the federal budget. He is frequently quoted in a number of major media outlets and works regularly with members of Congress and their staffs on budget-related issues. In 2010, Mr. Goldwein spent nine months as associate director of the National Commission on Fiscal Responsibility and Reform (The Fiscal Commission) and, in 2011, he spent three months as a senior budget analyst on the Joint Select Committee on Deficit Reduction (The Super Committee). He has also conducted research for the Government Accountability Office, the World Bank, the Historian's Office at the Social Security Administration and the Institute of Governmental Studies at University of California Berkeley. In addition to his work at CRFB, Mr. Goldwein teaches economics at Johns Hopkins University, where he was the 2013 recipient of an Excellence in Teaching Award. In 2011, he was featured in the Forbes 30 Under 30 Law & Policy list.
