Michael Kwiatkowski joined the United Brotherhood of Carpenters on October 14, 1998 as an apprentice out of Northwest Indiana. Working mainly in the Heavy Highway and Industrial sectors of the construction industry, Mike has held the role of steward, foreman, and general foreman.

He was hired by the Indiana Regional Council of Carpenters as a Business Representative / Organizer in 2006 and then went on to become a Senior Representative for the IN/Ky/Oh Regional Council. In 2014 Mike was hired by the United Brotherhood of Carpenters as the Midwestern District Representative and later served as a General Representative for the UBC. Mike is still a Chairman or Trustee on numerous pension funds, health and welfare funds, annuity funds, and training funds.

In 2021, Mike came back to the Indiana/Kentucky/Ohio Regional Council of Carpenters, where he was appointed to Executive Secretary-Treasurer and then elected by the delegate body in 2023.

General President Douglas McCarron appointed Mike to serve in the position of Midwestern District Vice-President of United Brotherhood of Carpenters and Joiners of America in October of 2023. District Vice-President Kwiatkowski assists the Midwestern Regional Councils, consisting of Mid-America, Central Midwest, and the Northern Midwest Regional Council. Whether working in the field or working as Representative, District Vice-President Kwiatkowski has always recognized and valued the importance of teamwork. The collaboration of organizing efforts, marketing campaigns, committees and more, amongst the Council's, has helped the membership in the Midwestern District grow to 134,000 members.
