Kevin McLaughlin is the Executive Secretary-Treasurer of the Mid-America Carpenters Regional Council, which represents over 57,000 members across Illinois, Iowa, Kansas, Missouri, and Nebraska. As Executive Secretary-Treasurer, Mr. McLaughlin oversees the union's day-to-day operations and serves as chairman of the MACRC's benefit and training funds.

He joined the union in 1984 as an apprentice with Carpenters Local 10, where he has served in various capacities including Delegate, Representative, Vice President, and President. He also served as Assistant to the President of the former Chicago Regional Council of Carpenters.

Before assuming his current position, Mr. McLaughlin was the National Trade Show Operations Representative for the United Brotherhood of Carpenters, where he led the union's trade show negotiations nationwide.

Mr. McLaughlin is also an active civic leader and holds positions on several state and local governing boards, including the Chicago Federation of Labor, Chicago and Cook County Building Trades, National Coalition of Labor, UBC Financial Oversight Committee, UBC Pension Fund, the Metropolitan Pier and Expo Authority (MPEA) Advisory Council, the Executive Committees of Choose Chicago (Chicago's Convention Bureau), the Chicago Sports Commission, Board of Directors of the Hibernian Media NFP, and a member of The Economic Club of Chicago.
